Early California is well-renowned as the outstanding choice for asparagus growers in hot and arid climates. It has no chilling requirement which makes it adaptable to season manipulation as it crops before all other asparagus hybrids. It is adapted to warm/hot growing environments and can be further manipulated with the use of protected cropping structures. The hybrid can be used in combination with other types in order to extend the harvest period over a longer season.

35.000 – 40.000 crowns per hectare would be standard practice at a depth of 15cm
